Filling out the VA-4 tax form

- 1. If you are exempt from state withholding (your total income in 2024 will be less than \$11,950 if filing singly or \$23,900 if filing jointly):
 - a. Fill out the boxes for your name, address, etc.
 - b. Check the box in line 3 **ONLY** (leave the lines for 1 and 2 blank).
 - c. Leave the box in line 4 blank unless the Service Member Relief Act happens to apply to you.
 - d. Sign.
- 2. If you are not exempt from state withholding (or you're not sure if you are):
 - a. Use the top section of the form to calculate your personal allowances/exemptions.
 - i. Most likely you will claim yourself (an allowance of 1).
 - a. Fill out the boxes for your name, address, etc.
 - b. Complete the lines for 1 and 2 (leave the box in line 3 blank).
 - c. Leave the box in line 4 blank unless the Service Member Relief Act happens to apply to you.
 - d. Sign.

2024 federal income tax withholding exemption criteria:

You are exempt from withholding in 2024 if you meet BOTH of these criteria:

- 1. You had NO tax liability in 2023. In other words,
 - a. You did not have to file a tax return in 2023, OR
 - b. Your total tax on line 24 of your 2023 Form 1040 (your tax return) is zero.
- 2. You expect to have NO tax liability in 2024. Specifically, your total income in 2024 will be less than the standard deduction for your filing status:

Filing status	2024 Standard deduction
Single/Married Filing Singly	\$14,600
Married Filing Jointly	\$29,200
Head of Household	\$21,900
Individual who can be claimed as a	\$1,300, OR your earned
dependent by someone else	income + \$450

Filling out the W-4 federal tax form

- 1. If you are exempt from federal withholding (according to the criteria above):
 - a. Complete the personal information section (step 1).
 - b. SKIP steps 2 through 4.
 - c. Write "Exempt" in the space below box 4(c).
 - d. Sign.
- 2. If you are not exempt from federal withholding (or you're not sure if you are):
 - a. Complete the personal information section (step 1).
 - b. Use the estimator at <u>www.irs.gov/W4app</u> and/or the additional worksheets on pages 3 and 4 of the form to help you decide which additional sections you need to complete (*if any*).
 - i. Complete step 2 IF you have multiple jobs.
 - ii. Complete step 3 IF you have dependents to claim.
 - iii. Complete step 4 **IF** you have other income, want to itemize your deductions, or want to withhold additional tax.
 - c. Sign.
